

King's Cross Station

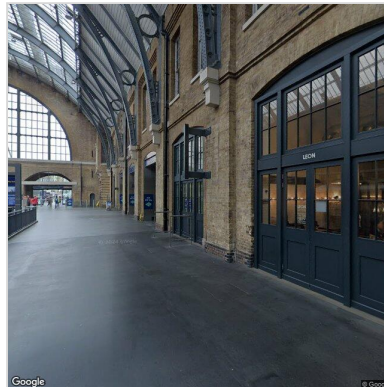
London — for arrivals, departures, and the hour in between.

Prepared 12 September 2026 · desk research + street-level imagery · no on-ground visit · north is up.

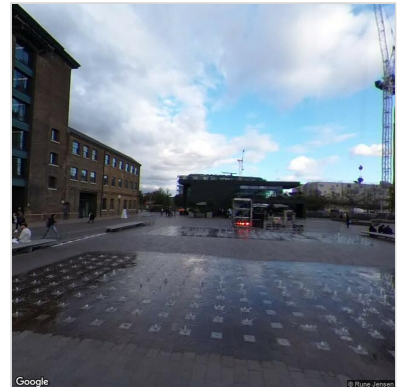
The station has two fronts. Euston Road on the south side has the Tube, buses, and taxis. The western exit points north toward Granary Square, Coal Drops Yard, and the Regent's Canal. If you have time to spend here, spend it north.



South front: Euston Road. Main entrance, Tube, buses, taxis.



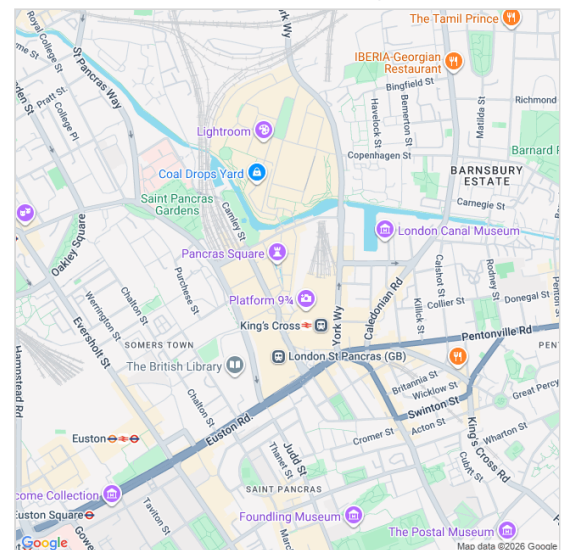
Concourse: arched roof, food, and the way to the platforms.



North side: Granary Square, fountains and benches, about eight minutes on foot.

► THE SHORT VERSION

- **Coming or going by train.** Main exits open onto Euston Road. For the north side, use the western concourse and walk up King's Boulevard.
- **Eating.** Solid options right at the station (Spagnoletti, German Gymnasium), quick and dependable east on Pentonville Road (Pizza Pilgrims, Flat Iron), and the strongest cluster north in Granary Square and Coal Drops Yard (Caravan, Coal Office).
- **Killing time.** British Library, five minutes south, free, with a good café inside. Or walk the canal towpath north. The Platform 9¾ trolley is in the main concourse if you want the photo.



King's Cross and St Pancras sit on Euston Road in the lower half of the frame; Granary Square, Coal Drops Yard, and the Regent's Canal are north, above them. Concourse to canal on foot: about eight minutes.

► GETTING OUT AND GETTING ON

- **Exits that matter:** Euston Road (main front) for Tube, buses, taxis; western concourse for King's Boulevard and the north development.
- **Tube:** King's Cross St Pancras serves six lines — Circle, Hammersmith & City, Metropolitan, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria. Entrances on Euston Road and from inside the station.
- **Taxis:** rank on the Euston Road forecourt. **Buses:** Euston Road and Pancras Road.
- **Rail:** St Pancras International for Eurostar and the Midlands is a two-minute walk; King's Cross for mainline north.

► WHAT'S AROUND

Walk times from the concourse, rounded up. Ratings are Google's, as of writing.

► WHAT I COULDN'T VERIFY

- **Photo dates:** the street-level photos are past Google Street View captures, not live shots. The scene can differ on the day (works, closures, weather).
- **Opening hours and prices:** not checked. Confirm before relying on them.
- **Walk times:** straight-line estimates rounded up, not measured routes. Treat as ± 2 minutes.
- **Building works and closures:** London changes weekly — check live before you go.

► HOW THIS WAS MADE

Desk research: Google Maps, Street View imagery, Google Places business data, and published transport facts, assembled and cross-checked by me. No walking, and no guessing dressed up as certainty. The gaps above are listed instead of hidden — that is the product, not a disclaimer.
